



2017 FRYE ISLAND FERRY INFORMATION

Issued: 02-9-17

Protruding loads from any vehicle or oversized vehicles will require an additional charge, upon the determination of the Captain. All Track vehicles must be on a trailer.
**ABSOLUTE MAXIMUM LOAD 7 yards gravel or fill, 4 ½ yards concrete. **

SPECIAL INFORMATION

1. USE FERRY AT YOUR OWN RISK; FERRY OPERATORS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR VEHICLE DAMAGE.
2. ONCE ON FERRY, THE DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED BY STATE LAW. IN ADDITION, FOR SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS, SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE FERRIES.
3. WHEN ARRIVING AT LANDING, TURN OFF LIGHTS, PULL IN MIRRORS AND WAIT FOR BOARDING INSTRUCTIONS.
4. ONCE ON FERRY, REMAIN IN VEHICLE; GETTING OUT OF YOUR CAR IS PROHIBITED, SET EMERGENCY BRAKE WHEN PARKED; TURN OFF ENGINE; WAIT FOR UNLOADING INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE FERRY CREW.
5. WHEN LEAVING THE ISLAND CALL FERRY TRAILER (207-655-4258) AT LEAST FIVE MINUTES BEFORE THE SCHEDULED TRIP. THE FERRY DOES NOT LEAVE THE MAINLAND WITHOUT A CALL FOR SERVICE, UNLESS VEHICLES HAVE BEEN LEFT WAITING.
6. NUMBER OF PEDESTRIANS ARE LIMITED TO NO MORE THAN 6 PER RUN.
7. THE FERRY CAPTAIN HAS THE DISCRETION TO DENY PASSAGE TO ANY UNRULY AND/OR INTOXICATED PASSENGERS

SPECIAL LIMITATIONS

1. PROPERTY OWNER VEHICLES WHICH ARE LARGER THAN A STANDARD BODY PICK-UP OR TRUCK ARE PERMITTED ON THE FERRIES ON FRIDAYS, SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS, AND HOLIDAYS. AS DECK SPACE ALLOWS.
2. COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED PASSAGE TO THE ISLAND SEVEN DAYS A WEEK DURING THE PRE & POST SEASONS ONLY. HOWEVER, THESE VEHICLES WILL BE REQUIRED TO WAIT UNTIL DECK SPACE ALLOWS. NO PROPERTY OWNER WILL BE DISPLACED ON THE FERRY BY THESE VEHICLES.

Times listed on this schedule are the first and last ferry trips from the mainland. The ferry departs on the hour and the half hour except when both boats are running; then departure is every 15 minutes. The first time listed indicates the time the primary ferry leaves from the mainland. The lower time listed indicates the times the second ferry will be in operation on that particular day. Ferry shuttling will affect departure times.

Regular scheduled ferry maintenance will affect the Wednesday 2nd boat during high season, during this ferry maintenance the main boat will shuttle constantly.

Late Runs – Policy and Fees

A late run is any run that follows the last scheduled departure from the mainland to the Island and is available for a maximum of 60 minutes after the last scheduled departure.

A resident must reserve the ferry by calling the ferry office at least ½ hr before last scheduled run (655-4258).

Examples are

- A late arrival after the last scheduled ferry departed from the mainland
- An Islander request for a late ferry in advance of the last scheduled departure

A fee, plus all applicable ferry tickets, will be charged for each individual vehicle. The rates for late runs will be:

- \$50, plus a ferry ticket for the first 30 minutes
- \$100, plus a ferry ticket for 30-60 minutes

All late runs are subject to prevailing weather conditions.

All monies will be collected by the crew and put into the day's receipts along with the proper backup paper work (late run sheet.)

Unscheduled Runs – Policy and Fees

Unscheduled runs are only for emergency situations. i.e. Fire/Medical

The "on duty" EMT will determine when a medical event will require an unscheduled transport. There is NO charge to passengers or vehicles while departing the Island for medical emergencies.

A fee of \$200, plus applicable ferry tickets will be charged for each individual vehicle for a return trip to the Island during time when no ferry service is scheduled. If involved vehicles return to the Island when ferry service is scheduled a courtesy transit will be extended to the involved parties.

Pre-Season:	April 29 – June 29
High Season:	June 30 – September 4th
Post Season:	September 5 th – Nov 1

Heavy Equipment Schedule: **

Pre-Season 8:00AM-4:00PM, Mon-Fri; No Sat, Sun or Holidays

High Season 8:00AM-4:00PM, Mon-Thurs, Fri 8:00AM-2:00PM, No Sat, Sun or Holidays

Post Season 8:00AM-4:00PM, Mon-Fri; No Sat, Sun or Holidays

No heavy equipment (i.e. gravel trucks, cement trucks delivery trucks etc.) will be allowed passage after the designated hours, on weekends and the Holidays of Memorial Day (May 29), July 4th, Labor Day (Sept 4) and Columbus Day (Oct 9).

**** Exception: As traffic permits or with permission from the ferry director**

The following vehicles will be expedited as soon as possible: USPS, Cement trucks, Pine Tree Waste (only when carrying for the Town), Store deliveries which are carrying perishable goods, Employees leaving island.
