Meeting Started 11:00

There was a brief discussion regarding financials. Revenues are up and the course is in good shape.

Laura explained the situation which resulted in the change of direction with regards to purchasing a new fleet of golf carts.

The Golf course has put into place a coupon drive which has gone well resulting in some additional revenue.

Paul Lyons recommended a volunteer starter on weekends to monitor the first Tee

John Kett suggested limiting access to the First Tee

Jim Hodge suggested and offered to pay for some sort of intercom/ wireless communication system to communicate with teams on the First Tee

It was suggested that all golfers - members and non members - be required to sign in at the club house

John Hodge suggested we table the idea of controlling the First Tee until the Winter Meeting

Laura Davis described the Face Book page of the Frye Island Golf Course and its function

The idea of a 9 hole rate was brought up and decided it had some merit and it was tabled until the Winter Meeting. Todd Keigwin has been in contact with the Maine Golf Trail and the Maine Golf Guide to increase our exposure to the golfing community in Maine.
